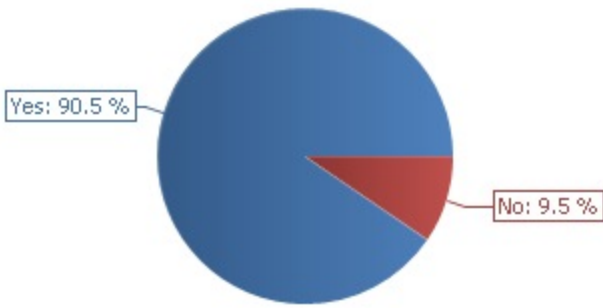

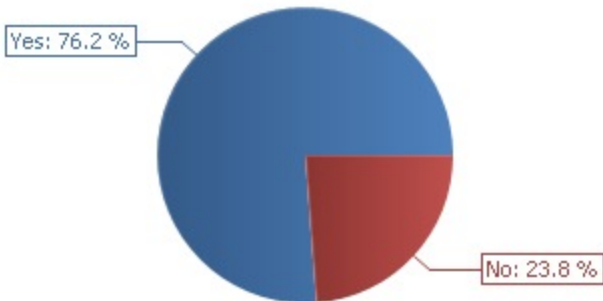
1.1. Do you want to adopt a Charter for the BBBHC?

2/19/2015	Anonymous	I think doing this would be a good guidestone for future work.

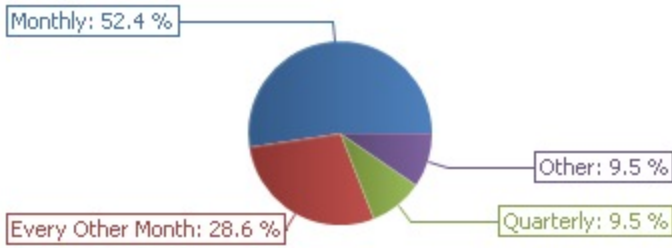
1.2. Do you want to adopt the IHI Model of Improvement as a framework for the BBBHC work?

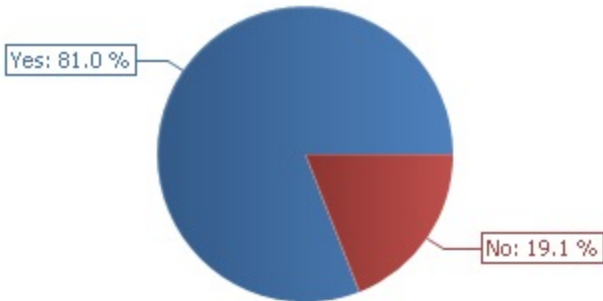

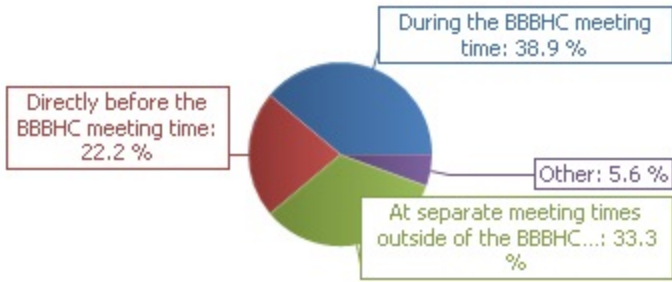
Answer

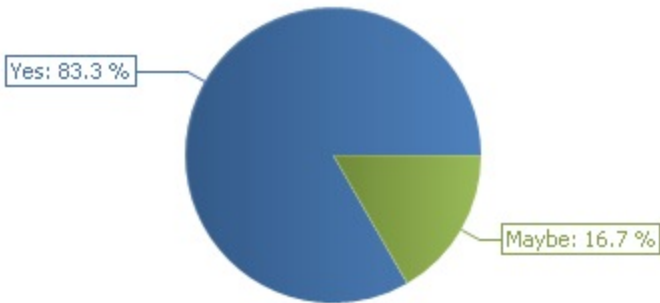

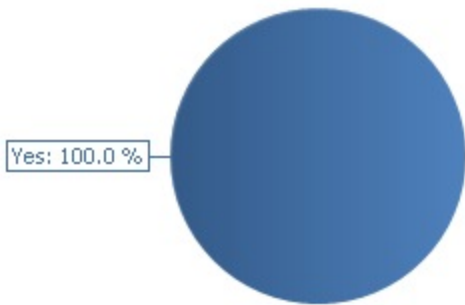
