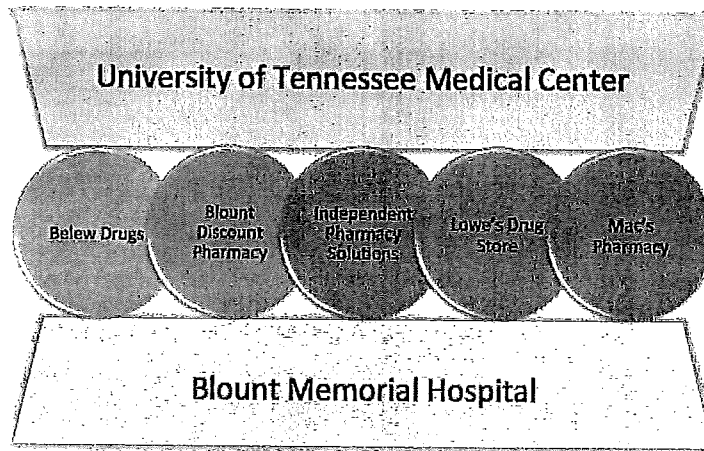


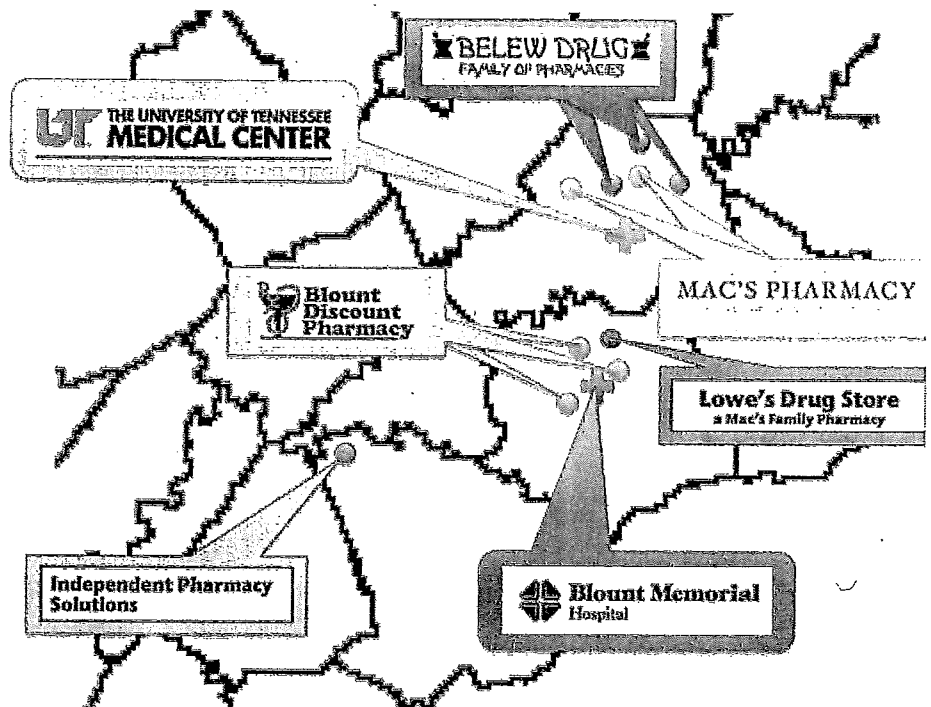
Building a Bridge to Better Health Coalition - Agenda 2/16/2016



- Pilot Program: An independent pharmacy panel for Transitions of Care services in East Tennessee.
 - Panel criteria: independent pharmacies currently offering MTM, CMR's, home visits, compliance packaging
- Example: Independent Panel of pharmacies for orphan drugs dependent on patient's location
- Services
 - Hospital discharged patients referred to pharmacist for comprehensive medication review (CMR) along with referral to organizations to meet social needs as deemed necessary.
 - Verify that discharged medications are filled.
 - Pharmacist and patient meet, either at pharmacy or an in-home visit, for CMR within 3 business days of hospital discharge.
 - Follow up 1 in two weeks; follow up 3 in one month - either by phone or in person.

• Patient Case Examples:

- BC (resident of Maryville, TN) is discharged after being admitted to Blount Memorial Hospital for a HF exacerbation. His doctor has sent him home with 3 new medications. Through the BBBHC-TOC program, BC has been given the option of the 4 pharmacies for which to follow up with a complete medication review. Being a resident of Maryville, TN; it makes sense that BC would choose to utilize this service through Blount Discount Pharmacy.
- CD (resident of Athens, TN) is discharged after being admitted to the UT Medical Center for her first MI. She is discharged with 2 new prescriptions. Through the BBBHC-TOC program, she would likely choose to utilize the TOC services provided by Independent Pharmacy Solutions in Sweetwater instead of driving to Knoxville.
