





Why Is Participation in Health Information Exchange through etHIN Important?

- Participating with etHIN can enable Community healthcare providers to:
 - Access real-time patient information anywhere you can access a browser
 - Receive and share information, or refer patients with/to other providers
 - Provide and access more information for clinical decisions, which should lead to safer, more effective care
 - Reduce provider costs related to faxing and associated personnel costs, redundant technology feeds, and duplicate testing
 - Promote early detection, prevention, and management of chronic diseases
 - Assure safety and security of patients' health information when sharing
 - Meet Meaningful Use objectives around data sharing
 - Facilitate a more expedient, audited Orders and Referrals Process within the community
